The Executive Chairperson

**Dear Students, Alumni, Parents, Guardians, Faculty, Staff and Promoter Friends and other Friends and Well-wishers of Xavier Academy,**

This Newsletter covers the major activities /developments in the college over the past 3 months, notably during the period April to June 2017! In most of the previous issues, both the news of Xavier Academy (XA) and KDBC were covered in one Newsletter. The April Newsletter of XA did not contain any news of KDBC. Therefore, this time, two different Newsletters have been prepared, with the XA Quarterly Newsletter, covering 3 months and KDBC Newsletter covering 6 months from January to June 2017.

One of the most significant developments during the last three months was the signing and exchanging of Memorandum of Understanding between Nepal Education Foundation – Consortium of Colleges, Nepal (NEF-CCN), including the sister college, KDBC, and Panyapiwat Institute of Management (PIM), the first and largest corporate University in Thailand, which follows work-based education philosophy with students spending 50% in class and 50% in the workplace. This event was held on 31 May 2017 in the gracious presence of HE Bhakavut Tanskul, the Ambassador of Thailand.

NEF-CCN has now signed MoUs/MoAs with 7 reputed Universities, namely, Angelo State University, Texas, USA, a reputed state university, Strathclyde Business School of University of Strathclyde, Glasgow, Scotland, awarded the title of the UK Business School of the year last year, International Management Institute, Luzern, Switzerland, 17th out of the top 20 hotel management schools in the world, SolBridge International School of Business, Daejeon, S. Korea, one of the top 5% business schools in the world, Mody University of Science Technology, Rajasthan, India, a leading women university and now Panyapiwat Institute of Management, Cheangwattana, Bangkok, Thailand, the first and largest and corporate university in Thailand.

All these MoUs/MoAs, will enable the students under the NEF-CCN umbrella, to go abroad to any of these universities, if they so wish, for their undergraduate and graduate programs on preferential terms, or opt to do 50% of the undergraduate or graduate program in Nepal and the remaining 50% in any of these universities, mainly for business studies. Under this 50%-50% arrangement, the studies will become very affordable.

This is always the busiest period of the year as we gear up for the new admission in Class XI Science and Management. The last 3 months were very hectic as the college undertook a significant amount of construction work, including constructing a one-storied structure to accommodate 2 laboratories at the back of the main building, constructing the walkway, creating a corridor to go to the laboratories, demolishing existing walls on the 2nd and 3rd floors and creating 4 more new classrooms, demolishing existing boys' and girls' toilets and creating modern toilets with more cubicles especially for the girls, renovating the kitchen and cafeteria, and installing A/C in the conference room etc. All these works have

definitely transformed Xavier Academy into a very modern college with one of the best facilities in the country at the +2 level.

This year will mark another milestone as we prepare to offer the BBA program under the Kathmandu Don Bosco College banner. We have done quite a bit of marketing for this, inviting potential students from different high schools to our college as well as visiting a number of colleges to explain about the BBA program.

This year will be most memorable because of the college's 20th Anniversary celebrations. Some of the activities related to the 20th Anniversary have already been completed such as the Felicitation program to the toppers and Student Council members of the outgoing batch as well as three Alumni meetings so as to involve our alumni in the 20th Anniversary celebratory activities. July will be a very busy month with the 5 day Inter College Debate Championship – Mahasangram 2017, followed by 3 day XA Model United Nations (XAMUN) with participation from at least 5 different countries, followed by Inter College Art and Essay Competitions, followed by Alumni Homecoming and Art and Science Exhibition. Subsequently, there will be Freshers' welcome and Dress Rehearsal and the main gala event on the 1st of August 2017. The 20th Anniversary celebratory events will end with social service and tree plantation on the 5th of August 2017.

We will be sending out invitations to parents, promoter friends, other friends and well-wishers for the grand event to be held on 1st of August 2017.

I am very excited about the 20th Anniversary celebratory activities. I hope all of you will help in whatever way you can to make this Anniversary a very memorable event.

### MEETINGS WITH PARENTS AND PRE-BOARD RESULT DISTRIBUTION

As in the past, meetings with parents/guardians of Class XI Science and Management students were organized on Saturday, 15 April 2017 (2 Baisakh 2074 BS) to discuss the NEF-CCN Pre-Board Exam results as well as to discuss with the parents of Grade XI Science morning shift the change-over from morning classes to day classes. During the meetings, the parents/guardians were explained that the results were not as expected and, therefore, this is a matter of concern, but, at the same time, this has been the trend for the past many years. Remedial classes, additional exams, and serious home study will improve the results in the final examinations.

With regard to the changeover, the parents/guardians were convinced of the many advantages of shifting science from morning to day not only to improve the attendance but also to improve the learning because students have more time to study and they can get proper home meal before coming to college. Non-performing students will be called for extra classes before the regular classes. These classes will be conducted under strict supervision by the subject teachers. There are other advantages as well. Due to the many benefits, the parents/guardians agreed to the changeover from morning science to day science. ### ADMISSION PROCEDURE DETAILS 2017

As in the previous years, Xavier Academy started the new admission procedure 2017, immediately after the publication of the SEE results, specifically from Thursday, 15 June onwards. As per the directive of the HSEB, the entrance examination was scheduled 2 weeks after the publication of the SEE results. The enrollment target for day Science XI is 4 groups and morning Management is 3 groups. The important dates are as follows:
