Letter from

the Executive Chairman Prof. Dr. Sriram Bhagut Mathe

Dear Students, Parents, Guardians, Faculty and Staff of Xavier Academy and Kathmandu Don Bosco College,

I am pleased to inform all of you that this Newsletter is the 4th Newsletter I am sharing with my students, parents/guardians, faculty and staff of both XA and KDBC, after I became the Chairperson of XA and KDBC as well as the Principal of XA in August 2015. The earlier 3 Newsletters were distributed in October 2015, January 2016 and April 2016. This Newsletter summarizes the important activities/developments of the two colleges during the 4-month period from mid-April to mid-August 2016 so that all the stakeholders are aware of the exciting developments and the students take pride in being Xavierians or KDBCians. As in the past, I will also be sharing this Newsletter with the Board Members of the two colleges.

At the very outset, I would like to CONGRATULATE all the XA students who passed the HSEB Class XII science examinations as well as all the MBA/EMBA students, who have successfully completed the various semesters, and would further like to wish them the very best in their future endeavors.

Let me also take this opportunity of wishing all the management students, who are anxiously waiting for their Class XII results as well as the MBA students, who have or will be appearing for their final examinations the very best in terms of their results as well as their future endeavours.

As I have stated in various orientation and other programs, I do hope that all the XA and KDBC students, past and present, will continue to excel in their studies and in whatever they do to achieve their dreams so that they make themselves, their parents, their teachers and institutions and, above all, their nation proud.

The 4 months of May to August always tend to be very hectic, as the college prepares for the new intake in Class XI. As soon as SLC results are published, the admission process for Class XI starts immediately. Therefore, the month of May was taken up by planning for the new academic year, including the finalization of the lesson plans and the academic calendar for both Classes XI and XII and printing of admission forms, the promotional flyers and brochures for the new intake. This year, new catalogue for XA had to be produced along with new flyers for KDBC. Most of June was taken up with dealing with admission enquiries, counseling the prospective students and in entertaining the application forms for Class XI Science and

Management. At the same time, classes of Class XII had to be started. Therefore, routines had to be finalized and orientation programs had to be conducted. This year, for the first time in XA's history, orientation/interaction programs were conducted for the benefit of the parents/guardians of Class XII students.

The month of July was very hectic conducting the entrance exam, interviewing the prospective students and enrolling them in Class XI and conducting orientation programs for the students as well as the parents/guardians. Again, the orientation programs for the parents/guardians of the Class XI students were the first of its type in XA history.

What made this 4-month period even more hectic was the construction work undertaken to improve and increase the usable spaces by roofing the top floor as well as renovating and increasing the number of rest rooms and changing the furniture of classrooms and repainting the interior of the building to provide the right ambience, conducive to studies.

All our efforts have paid off with the total XA student enrollment increasing to 525 from 441 last year. Altogether 193 new students have enrolled in Class XI Science (compared to 133 last year) and 101 new students in Management (compared to 98 last year). We have achieved this enrollment against cut-throat tuition fees competition. The enrollment of 525 is the 5th highest enrollment in our 20 years of student intake.

We are now gearing to offer the BBA program from the coming academic session. This program is in addition to the MBA and EMBA programs we are currently offering under KDBC.

I am happy to report that we celebrated our 19th NEF and XA Anniversary on the 1st of August in our usual distinct style with lots of cultural programs and Mr. & Miss Fresher Contest. KDBC also celebrated freshers' welcome and farewell party.

In the ongoing academic year, we have introduced many interesting co-curricular and extra-curricular activities to make our students excellent not only in studies but in many aspects related to total personality development.

In conclusion, I would like to welcome all the new students as well as their parents/guardians into the XA family. We would like to assure you that we will do our very best to justify the trust that you have placed on us!

I end this message by sharing with you my favourite quotation from **Aristotle** (384-322 BC), the great Greek Philosopher:

INTERACTION MEETINGS WITH CLASS XII PARENTS

For the first time in XA history, the Chairman / Principal decided that meetings should be held with the parents/guardians of Class XII students, before the start of Class XII classes, so that they are not only refreshed on the values, the norms, motto and vision of XA, but also the enrollment and final results scenario over the past 18 years, academic calendar for 2073-74, the homework system, co-curricular, extra-curricular and social activities to be conducted this academic year. They were requested to closely monitor the studies of the students at home so that all the students gain the required knowledge and perform well in all the examinations so that XA can be the top +2 school in the near future.

Altogether 4 meetings were held, in which altogether 191 parents / guardians (113 parents / guardians of Science and 78 of those of Management students) attended the meetings.

In the meetings, the Chairman/Principal made a power point presentation to ensure better understanding of all the main important points to be borne in mind by the parents/guardians. These meetings were attended by members of the senior management as well as by those faculty and staff, who were free from their duties.

The first meeting was held on 4 June 2016 with the parents/guardians of Management Day Shift students, so as to get their approval (i) on the changing of the day shift to morning shift due to the low student enrollment in the day shift, and (ii) the additional Rs. 500.00 which has been charged from this year to cover the extra class every Tuesday to conduct co-curricular activities and extra class every Friday to conduct extra-curricular activities.

Three more meetings were held on 6 June 2016 with the parents/guardians of Management morning shift students, on 8 June 2016 with the parents/guardians of Science Biology group students, and on 10 June 2016 with the parents / guardians of Science Mathematics group students.

The parents/guardians were very happy that XA had conducted the meetings and assured the XA management of their full cooperation in ensuring the success of all academic activities. The parents/guardians of management day shift students approved the changing of day shift to morning shift and all the parents/guardians also approved the extra Rs. 6,000.00 charged every annually for co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.



ORIENTATION FOR CLASS XII STUDENTS

The Orientation program for Class XII students was held over **3 sessions** on **Monday**, **20 June 2016**, basically to refresh them on our values, norms, long-term vision to be the best +2 school in Nepal as well as on the academic calendar, the homework system this year, the disciplinary code, the co-curricular, extra-curricular and social activities to be conducted this year. The Chairman/Principal gave a motivational speech accompanied by power point presentation and exhorted the students to work hard not only to realize their dreams but to make XA the best +2 college in Nepal.

The first session was conducted for the benefit of Management XII A and B students. The second session was conducted for the benefit of Management XII C and Science XII C students. The third session was conducted for the Science XII A and Science XII B students. All students were explained the important/key dates of the academic calendar. CLASS XI ADMISSION

Soon after the publication of the SLC results on 16 June 2016, the admission process started the very next day on 17 June and the entrance examination was held on 2 July, the results were published that very same evening and the interview was held on 4 July 2016. Altogether 192 science and 101 management students were admitted and the classes started on 26 July 2016. The number of applicants, the number who appeared in the entrance and in the interview and the numbers finally admitted in science and management are given in the following table:

This international tie-up with SolBridge as well as tieup of Asian Institute of Technology and Management (AITM), which also comes under the umbrella of NEF-CCN, with International Management Institute, Luzern, Switzerland, have opened new study opportunities for our students. The international partnerships with SolBridge, S. Korea, and IMI, Switzerland, were extensively discussed during "Meet the Press", which was held following the OPEN HOUSE. It was mentioned during the Press Meet that discussion was ongoing with Strathclyde Business School, one of the top business schools in UK to sign a MoA in November 2016 to provide additional study opportunities abroad besides S. Korea and Switzerland under partnership agreements.
