- XA is planning to enroll 280 students (8 groups: 3 groups science morning, 3 groups management morning and 2 groups science day) in Class XI, in the coming academic session 2024/2025.
- To achieve this enrollment target, XA is planning to organize a number of Open Houses, the first one on Saturday, April 27, 2024.
- For those of us who are a bit advanced in age and for our elderly guests, who have to go to the Conference Hall on the top floor, we are planning to install a lift. This has been in the works for a

number of years. Finally, we have decided to install this lift in the next few months, so that the lift is installed by 1st July 2024, when our new academic session for Class XII will start.

- XA will be celebrating the 27th Anniversary on 1st August 2024.
- The international edition of XAMUN 2024, one of our two flagship events, will be held in the second half of August 2024. As in the past, this will be an international event with foreign delegates and foreign dais members.
- XA will also organize the international edition of the annual debating championship either in the last week of August or between Dashain and Tihar.
- XA is planning to construct a modern building in front of the existing building. The foundation laying ceremony of this new building will be conducted as part of our 30th Anniversary celebration in 2027.


Students, please remember always that
